How To Get There

Visitors may park at the Caltrans Skeggs Point parking area on the east side of Highway 35 (Skyline Boulevard), about 4 miles north of Highway 84 (La Honda Road) and 1.5 miles south of Kings Mountain Road. (Please note that Caltrans prohibits a left turn into the lot when approaching from the north along Skyline Boulevard.) From there, the El Corte de Madera Creek Trail/Tafoni Trail entrance is slightly to the north and across Skyline Boulevard. Very limited roadside parking on Skyline Boulevard and access to the Methuselah Trail entrance is located approximately 2.2 miles south of Kings Mountain Road; limited parking on Skyline Boulevard and access to the Gordon Mill Trail is approximately 2.7 miles south of Kings Mountain Road.
